SEMI-FORMAL ATTIRE

- What's semi-formal? A semi-formal dress code is best described as being more formal than what you would wear to an office, but slightly less formal than what you would wear to a formal event.
- Button up shirts, polo shirts, and ties are not necessary but are optional
- Clean pants. Slacks or dark wash jeans (Jeans with holes or distressed, are not considered semi-formal)
- Dresses, floor length gowns are not necessary. Opt for knee-length dresses or above the knee.
- Skirts. Opt for knee-length, or just above the knee.
